



Leaving Certificate Geography Investigation

The Leaving Certificate Geography Investigation at INFF follows the headings of the report booklet, so that students can make the most of their time at INFF.

Classroom Introduction

During this session, students use OS maps, aerial photographs and GIS maps to decide on a suitable field site. Through group discussion, students form hypotheses and plan the investigation.



Gathering Information

Field session in which students make observations, draw a field sketch of the site and take and record measurements decided on during the planning stage.



Classroom Follow-up

Students put together a table of results, draw relevant graphs and examine the results to draw conclusions and determine whether or not their hypotheses were correct. Students then evaluate their work.
